Reminder:

Delegates from Locals which are more than two months in arrears with per capita payments shall not be seated as voting delegates, but as visitors. (Bylaw Article 6).

EWSC By-Laws - ARTICLE 9 – LOCAL ASSISTANCE

1. When attending the Annual Conference or Education Workers' Steering Committee sponsored events, delegates or delegates' expenses shall be the responsibility of their Local Union.
2. The Education Workers' Steering Committee shall reimburse Local Unions of fifty (50) members or less for fifty (50%) percent of the cost to the Local, to a maximum of Two Hundred and Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars for paying lost wages, hotel and transportation of one (1) delegate to attend an Education Workers' Steering Committee Annual Conference and to any Schools or Meetings sponsored by the Committee. Requests for reimbursement are to be in the hands of the Secretary-Treasurer, within sixty (60) days, by the close of the Conference, School or Meeting provided that all Locals applying for reimbursement shall have a dues structure of no less than 1.5%.
3. The Education Workers' Steering Committee shall reimburse Local Unions who register a young worker (under 30 years of age) for fifty (50%) of the cost to the local, to a maximum of Two Hundred and Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars for paying lost wages, hotel and transportation for one (1) delegate who has been designated as a young worker to attend an Education Workers' Steering Committee Annual Conference and to any Schools or Meetings sponsored by the Committee. Requests for reimbursement are to be in the hands of the Secretary-Treasurer, within sixty (60) days, by the close of the Conference, School or Meeting provided that all Locals applying for reimbursement shall have a dues structure of no less than 1.5 percent. This will be limited to the first three Locals who apply for young worker assistance.
